

The Stained Glass Museum

Study Weekend - Suffolk

Thursday 19 - Sunday 22 April 2018

Programme

The Museum's 2018 Study Weekend will take place in Suffolk, where we will be based in the historic market town of Bury St Edmunds, former home to one of the richest Benedictine abbeys in medieval England.

On Thursday afternoon we will begin our visits on foot in Bury St Edmunds town centre, taking in Council Offices with a good collection of 20th century Arts and Craft roundels, the Cathedral (which houses 16th century Flemish glass and a number of good 19th century windows) and St Mary's and St John's churches with very good collections of 19th century glass including interesting examples by Heaton, Butler and Bayne.

Friday and Saturday will be spent on the coach touring the local area to visit medieval glass at Long Melford, Risby, Gipping and Hessett, an important collection of 16th and 17th century roundels at Nowton, 17th century Heraldic glass at Clare and High Victorian glass at Sudbury and Lavenham. We will also see some beautiful early Henry Holiday glass at Shimpling and fine Arts and Crafts stained glass at Horringer and Herringswell.

On Sunday there will be the opportunity of exploring the town of Bury St Edmunds including the Abbey ruins and Abbey and Moyses Hall museum.

Accommodation

We will be staying in The Angel Hotel, a 4 star luxury hotel in the centre of Bury St Edmunds, close to the Cathedral grounds and 15 minutes' walk from the rail station. Free car parking for guests is available at the hotel.
