### Glass Painting Tutor (freelance)

The Stained Glass Museum would like to invite applications for a professionally-trained, skilled, creative and enthusiastic freelance Workshop Tutor to run Glass Painting Workshops for adults at The Stained Glass Museum in 2019. This is an opportunity to join our growing community, contribute to an existing successful specialist workshop programme and help develop it for future audiences.



Glass Painting workshops at the Stained Glass Museum are typically of one-day duration (10am - 5pm) and held on Fridays or Saturdays (2019 dates to be agreed with the tutor). Typically the Museum aims to run 6-8 glass painting workshops per year, between February and November. Our one-day workshops are aimed at all levels and suitable for beginners, although we would also like to develop some longer 2-3 day workshops for those looking to refine or develop skills.

Applicants should hold a suitable qualification and have relevant experience of glass painting and other arts, as well as experience teaching. An enthusiastic and flexible approach is essential.

Workshop Tutors are engaged as freelancers (paid an agreed fee per workshop) and an agreement is held between the Stained Glass Museum and its Workshop Tutors. Dates are mutually agreed by both parties. The Stained Glass Museum handles all workshop bookings, and is responsible for advertising workshops. It also provides the venue (The Stained Glass Museum workshop area within the south triforium of Ely Cathedral), equipment and materials, including light boxes and gas kiln.

The Stained Glass Museum has a national collection of stained glass windows, associated designs, cartoons and tools which tell the story of the development of this unique art form from the 13<sup>th</sup> century to the present day. Located in the south triforium of Ely Cathedral (accessed by a staircase of 40 steps), the Museum is an independent accredited museum and registered charity (1169842) governed by a Board of Trustees and managed by a small team of staff. The museum's workshop programme is a key part of its educational activities.
