Stained glass panel showing two angels with red and pink wings holding scrolls under two classical archways with a central pillar between them. The scrolls tell us about the good deeds of the female figure below, who has been identified as Dorcas. The top half of Dorcas, who wears a blue robe and white headress and carries a bundle of cloth, is visible in this panel.


