**Brief description:** Surviving stained glass base panel of a lancet window. Emblem of St Peter. Angel bearing inscribed scroll with above inscription. Designed by John Hardman Powell, made by John Hardman and Co, 1852.

Angel in profile bearing inscribed scroll. Inscription above. Yellow borders, red and blue grounds, beaded and foliate borders


