



## Kneeling Angel

**Brief description:** Top panel of two lancets of The Good Samaritan designed by Harrington Mann and made by J and W Guthrie, 1893. Forms upper part of picture of kneeling angel facing right, head bowed, yellowish green dress, orange sash, cream wings, simple halo.

Forms upper part of picture of one of a pair of angels (one on the matching panel) kneeling and facing each other. Angel kneels, head bowed, yellowish-green dress with orange sash, cream wings, simple halo. White background.
