



Kneeling Angel

Brief description: Base panel from lancet which depicts a kneeling angel designed by Harrington Mann and made by J and W Guthrie, 1893. Forms lower part of picture of kneeling angel facing right, head bowed, yellowish green dress, orange sash, cream wings, simple halo.

Forms lower part of picture of one of a pair of angels (top part of the matching panel is missing) kneeling and facing each other. Angel kneels, yellowish-green dress with orange sash, cream wings, bare feet. White background.
