Brief description: Base panel from lancet of The Good Samaritan designed by Harrington Mann and made by J and W Guthrie, 1893. Forms lower part of a kneeling angel.

Forms lower part of picture of one of a pair of angels (top panel is missing) kneeling and facing each other. Angel kneels, facing left, yellowish-green dress with orange sash, cream wings, bare feet. White background.
