Brief description: Stained glass decorative panel with symbol, IHS. Made by C E Clutterbuck, in about 1867.

Stained glass decorative panel. The letter P X are acid etched and stained on a decorative red background. This forms a central circular motif. The rest of the panel is a strongly patterned symmetrical design of foliage. Made by Charles Edmund Clutterbuck, in about 1867.


