Brief description: Stained glass panel depicting Saint Mary Magdalene discovering Jesus's resurrection. Made by C E Clutterbuck, in about 1867.

Stained glass panel depicting the biblical story of Jesus Christ's resurrection. Jesus has a halo and wears a blue gown under a red robe. Kneeling at his left is Mary Magdalene. An empty rock tomb is behind on the right. Christ's hands are uplifted and bear the stigmata. Mary wears a white gown under a patterned yellow cloak. Made by Charles Edmund Clutterbuck, in about 1867.


