Brief description: Stained glass panel. A copy of the head of Jacob from a 13th century window. Painted by Thomas Cowell in about 1920.

Painted face of a man. Head facing 3/4 fwd to right. Regular painted curls along hairline and hair parted going straight back from brow. Leaded in 2 pieces with hooks at top. With Cowell's drawing of the original on thick paper with inscription bottom right hand corner.
