Brief description: Maquette for a mandorla stained glass window designed by Ervin Bossanyi in the late 1940s depicting Christ in Majesty with book in left hand and right hand raised in a gesture of blessing

This is an alternative design for a stained glass mandorla, a maquette made of coloured transparent plastic. It depicts bearded Christ dressed in white shirt with red stole, pink and blue skirt and bare feet. He is seated on a red, blue, and white globe with a red cruciform nimbus and holding a book on his left knee with his left hand, his right hand raised in blessing and a further mandorla encircling his upper body with wavy lines in brown to either side.
