Mother Holding a Child



BESSANY, E. B. (1881-1957) English stained glass artist. Born in London, England. Studied at the Royal College of Art, London. Worked for the Arts and Crafts movement. Designed and made stained glass windows for churches and private homes. His work is characterized by its simplicity and use of bold colors. He was a member of the Arts and Crafts movement and the Society of Stained Glass Artists. His work is highly regarded and his influence is still felt today.
