

Christ in Majesty

Brief description: Design for a stained glass window depicting Christ in Majesty with angels and saints below. Designed by Heaton, Butler and Bayne

A design for a stained glass window made up of five lancets and three roses with tracery. The lancets depict Jesus Christ in majesty. He sits in heaven on a rainbow; at his feet is a cloud. Rays of light shine around him. Angels are at either side of him. Below on earth are nimbed figures of saints and clergymen. The signs of alpha and omega are in the rose, as well as the Star of David. Also in the rose are latin symbols from Christ.


