



Christ and the Apostle & Methodism in America

Brief description: Framed design for a stained glass window depicting Christ with Apostles in the centre light and a depiction of Philip Embury and Barbara Heck in the outer lights. Designed by Heaton, Butler and Bayne

A design for a stained glass window made up of three lights. The centre light, which is wider than the outer panels, depicts Jesus Christ with the Apostles. Jesus has his arm raised, he wears a halo. The figures are standing on a mountain, with trees and birds in the background. The left light shows figures identified as Philip Embury and Barbara Heck, who were important in the setting up of Methodism in the USA. Embury holds a bible, and behind him a building, church, is being constructed. He is surrounded by wood as he was a carpenter. Heck is also holding a bible and possibly a candle. In the background a ship is sailing away and two other figures are walking away from it.

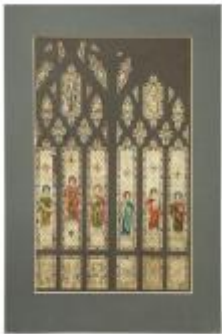
