Brief description: Design for a stained glass window depicting Jesus ascending to heaven. Designed by Heaton, Butler and Bayne

Two lights, the third is missing. In the centre of the left light Jesus is rising, his arms are raised and he is wearing a halo. Above him is an angel, below are apostles, they have no faces. The right panel shows an angel (not complete) and below are apostles (not complete).




