



## Transfiguration & Christ by the sea of Tiberius & Request for St James and St John & Christ with Ss James and John

**Brief description:** Design of a stained glass window depicting the transfiguration, Christ by the sea of Tiberius, the request for St James and St John, and Christ with St James and John. Designed by Heaton, Butler and Bayne

A design for a stained glass window made up of two lights, showing four scenes. The top left scene shows the transfiguration shows Jesus with his arms raised, he is nimbed and has rays of light surrounding him. At his feet are Saints Peter, John and James. In the roundels either side of him are Moses and Elijah. The bottom left scene shows Christ by the sea of Tiberias. A nimbed Jesus is standing facing a boat which is full on haloed figures, one of the figures (Simon?) holds a fishing net. The boat has a striped sail. The top of the right light shows Jesus, wearing a halo, standing with four other haloed men and a woman knelt at his feet. The bottom scene shows Jesus with James and possibly John standing in front of a city. The right light has decorative borders and apex panel.
