Brief description: Stained glass base panel depicting a flying angel offering a chalice to Jesus Christ with St James sleeping in the centre. There are four soldiers in background, and Judas is among them. Designed by R T Bayne and made by Heaton, Butler and Bayne, 1865.

St James in the centre of the scene resting on his arm while he sleeps. Behind him is Paul. In the background are four soldiers wearing helmets, one carrying a lantern.
