



## Two figures

**Brief description:** Stained glass panel from centre of second from left light. Panel shows the head and shoulders of two historical figures, perhaps a monk and a cleric. It also shows part of an inscription which reads- Thou. This part of the panel depicts historical figures. Made by Henry Gustave Hiller, 1904

Stained glass panel from centre of middle left light. Panel depicts two figures, one on the left hooded- possibly a monk, figure on the right holds a book and wears a black hat- possibly a cleric. Above are the lower legs and feet of the figures in the second register of biblical figures.
