The Stained Glass Museum was founded over 40 years ago to rescue and preserve examples of stained glass and display them to the public. In 1979 the Museum opened to the public in Ely Cathedral. Following a complete refurbishment in 2000 the Museum now displays over 125 fine pieces spanning the medieval to modern era. It is the only museum in the United Kingdom devoted to stained glass, and displays a variety of windows from religious and secular buildings.

In addition, we hold a variety of temporary exhibitions throughout the year. We also run an educational programme for schools and groups of children as well as practical workshops, events and activities for all ages.

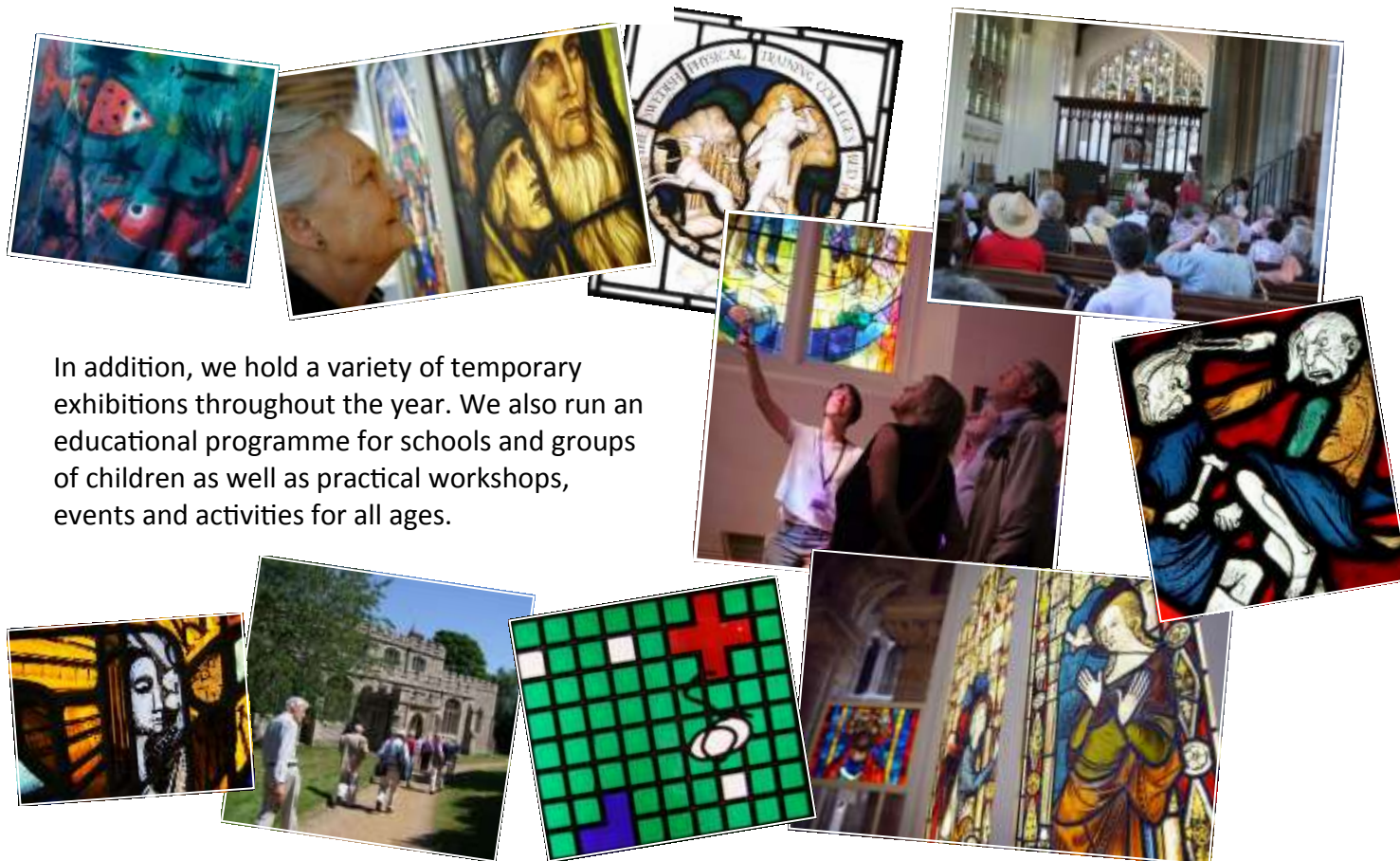
