ABOUT THE MUSEUM

The Stained Glass Museum is the only museum dedicated to the art of stained glass in the UK. The museum boasts a Nationally Designated collection of stained glass, associated designs, materials and tools which reveal the development of this unique art from the 13th century to present day.

The museum's permanent gallery space in the triforium of Ely Cathedral houses a chronological display featuring stained glass from the museum's own collection as well as from partner organisations the V&A and the Royal Collection. Displayed at eye-level, visitors can experience this art form at close quarters.

An independent accredited museum and registered charity since its foundation in 1972, The Stained Glass Museum has rescued a large quantity of stained glass from redundant buildings, many of them churches and chapels, but also synagogues, hospitals, houses and schools, which otherwise would have been lost.

MAKING AND MENDING: CONSERVATION TOURS

This curator-led tour of the gallery offers a closer look at the technical craft and intricate conservation of stained glass. Discover the specialist techniques used to care for these remarkable windows, both historically and today uncovering hidden details and restoration histories of windows on display. Plus, enjoy the opportunity to handle pieces from our handling collection and explore the tools and materials used to create, repair and conserve stained glass.

MAKE A DAY OF IT: THE ELY EXPERIENCE

The Stained Glass Museum is located inside Ely Cathedral and there is plenty to do in the building to fill a day's itinerary.

Nearby attractions include Ely Museum, and Oliver Cromwell's House (all within walking distance). The Museum is also a 15 minute train ride, or 30 minutes drive from Cambridge, and can easily be combined with a visit to one of Cambridge's many attractions.

TAKE A BREAK

Although the museum does not have a café, Ely Cathedral's Almonry Restaurant located in the Cathedral grounds is also very close by. There are a number of independent and national coffee shops and cafés in the city, all within 5-10 minute walking distance.
